



BEHAVIOR CHART

7th – 12th grade students

Learning requires dedication, motivation, responsibility, and discipline among other things. In order to encourage students to do their best in the area of discipline, the Cupeyville School administration has established a 100 point conduct grade per semester per class for each student from 7th to 12th grade. Students who follow the established rules and regulations as stated in the Student Handbook and who also follow classroom rules as well, will receive **100 points for outstanding conduct at the end of each semester in each of his or her classes.**

However, the following points will be deducted from the conduct grade in each of the following areas every time a student fails to comply with any of the rules listed below.

<p>I. Uniform</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shirt out (boys) • No belt (boys) • Wrong shirt, jackets, sweaters, shoes or socks • Folding the skirts • Blouse (girls) excessive cleavage, colored underwear • Using PE uniform on a day when there is no PE • Using the wrong jacket • Beard (boys) <p><i>*Student will be sent to Dean of Discipline for parents referral if:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not wearing a vest underneath a jacket (girls) • Wearing casual clothes instead of school uniform • Wearing short skirt (not more than 2 inches above the knee) • Boys not wearing polo underneath their jacket • The student needs to shave or needs a haircut • Wearing tattoos 	<p>- 2 points</p>
<p>II. Books and Materials</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not coming prepared with your books and materials to class 	<p>- 3 points</p>
<p>III. Tablet and Laptop</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not bringing to class the tablet or laptop/materials needed for class • Not having your tablet/laptop ready for use(charged) • Beign on inappropriate websites 	<p>-3 points</p> <p>-5 points Plus written notification</p>
<p>IV. Food, Drink, Gum Chewing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bringing food or drinks to the classroom after PE class • Eating or drinking in the classroom without permission (Only drinking water is permitted at any time) • Chewing gum in the classroom 	<p>- 2 points</p>

<p>V. Misbehavior</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Running or jumping over desk in the classroom • Sitting on top of a desk or on top of a teacher’s desk • Throwing any object at anyone • Leaving trash on the floor • Working on homework or classwork from another class • Repetitive interruptions • Falling asleep in the classroom 	<p>- 2 points</p> <p>-5 points</p>
<p>VI. Late to Class</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Late to class (excused only if you bring a written note from the Dean of Discipline, administration, nurse, a counselor or another teacher) 	<p>- 2 points</p>
<p>VII. Language</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Foul language • Incessant talking, unnecessary noises or screaming 	<p>- 5 points Plus written notification</p>
<p>VIII. Cell Phone, IPod, other electronic devices use during class time</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Making and receiving phone calls or texts • Using the phone for devious purposes • Taking pictures or videos • Playing games on your phone • Using IPods or any other electronic devices without permission <p>*Refer to the Tablet/Laptop Policy in the Student Handbook for penalties regarding the misuse of devices in class and around school grounds.</p>	<p>- 5 points Plus confiscation of device</p>
<p>IX. Damaging school property and equipments</p>	<p>Disciplinary referral Plus payment of equipment</p>
<p>X. Bullying</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Verbal, physical, emotional or cyberbullying 	<p>Disciplinary referral</p>
<p>XI. Cutting Class</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cutting class • Leaving the classroom without permission • Excusing yourself from the class for a valid reason and then not returning promptly or at all without a valid written excuse 	<p>- 10 points Plus disciplinary referral</p>
<p>XII. Academic Dishonesty</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Copying tests/homework • Plagiarism <p>-----</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Forging parent’s signature 	<p>0 on the work assigned Plus disciplinary referral</p> <p>-----</p> <p>-10 points Plus disciplinary referral</p>
